Dear Grand Blanc Academy Parents and Family Members,

Thank you for choosing Grand Blanc Academy for your child!

Grand Blanc Academy receives funds from the Title I, Part A program. Title I, Part A is a federal, supplemental program designed to help children reach high academic standards. In receiving these funds Grand Blanc Academy is required to inform you, as parents of children attending a Title I school, of information available to you regarding the professional qualifications of your child's teacher(s). Information will be provided to you **upon request and in a timely manner** of the following:

1. Whether your child's teacher has met Michigan qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction.
2. Whether your child's teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which Michigan qualification or licensing criteria have been waived.
3. The baccalaureate degree major of your child's teacher and any other graduate certification or degree held by the teacher, and the field of discipline of the certification or degree.
4. Whether your child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.

You will also receive timely notice if your child is, for whatever reason, assigned or taught for four or more consecutive weeks, by a teacher who is not highly qualified. A highly qualified teacher would be defined as a teacher that meets Michigan's qualification and licensing criteria for the grade level or subject area in which the teacher is providing instruction.
